

Nut Allergy

Please be advised that some children in school have been identified as having a <u>severe nut</u> <u>allergy</u>. As you will be aware, allergies can be very serious and can have life threatening consequences. Therefore, we must have your co-operation to manage this and keep all of the children safe and well.

We ask that children do not bring nuts or any food or sweets containing nuts to school. Don't forget, nut butters or Nutella sandwiches as well as some cereal bars are unsuitable.

MEDICINES POLICY
